
Ballet Recital Make-up

Make-up Application

Tip: Wash and Moisturize before applying make-up: It's always a great idea to wash the face even with a damp washcloth and dry. Applying a thin layer of moisturizer will help when removing the make-up later.

Tip: Proper Attire: Have your dancer wear a button down shirt/sweater that you don't mind getting dirty just in case.

- **1. Eye Shadow** Shade in the eye lid, from inside corner to outside corner, lashes to the crease of lid.
- 2. Mascara- Just on the top lashes.
 - a. *Tip*: Gently press the eyebrow up and have them blink, brushing the mascara brush up as they do.
- **3. Eyebrow Pencil** Shade in their existing eye brow starting from center moving out.
- **4. Blush** Have your dancer suck in their cheeks to expose cheek bones and brush with a blush brush, making a sweeping motion up into the hairline from under apples of cheek bone.
 - a. *Tip*: The Blush should not be lower than the lips or directly on the "apples" of the cheeks.
- **5. Lipstick** Fill in the whole lip area making sure to blot off excess lipstick with a tissue.
 - a. Tip: If you use a lipstick brush it will be easier to apply.

Tip: After The Show: Wash face with gentle cleanser or make-up remover and re-apply moisturizer as desired.
